**Changes to Live Streaming of Masses From Abbeyfeale via Webcam  
 Jan 2025**

Recently we installed Fibre Optic Broadband here in the Church to help in-  
 crease the quality of the live feed of Masses and other events via our Webcam,  
 and this improvement was confirmed to us immediately by many of those who  
 watch Mass from their homes.

To continue with the improvement of overall services we are now in the pro-  
 cess of moving to a different provider of this service,  
 with the changeover expected to begin on or close to Wed 1<sup>st</sup> Jan

If you watch Mass via our Webcam from the Abbeyfeale Parish Website, you  
 don't need to do anything as this changeover will happen automatically.

If you watch Mass via our Webcam from the Church Services TV Website, this  
 is expected to cease on or close to Wed 1<sup>st</sup> Jan.
